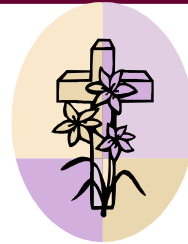

**What is TreasureFest?** TreasureFest – God’s Family Gathering of Time, Talent and Treasure, is an event showcasing the musical and artistic talents of the 45 Archdiocesan schools. Student musical performances will take place between 3-5:15 p.m. All participating students will join in a finale with Kansas City’s very own nationally recognized jazz musician, Ron Gutierrez. TreasureFest will conclude with an exciting performance by Catholic rock band, The Thirsting, from 5:45-7 p.m. In addition to the main stage performances, student artwork will be displayed and booth vendors will be available to provide information that pertains to Catholic education.

**What is The Thirsting?** The Thirsting is a 5-piece Catholic alternative/rap/rock band from Vancouver, Washington. Under the direction of band leader Daniel Oberreuter, The Thirsting offers cutting-edge Catholic music that speaks to the youth of today. Lyrically, there is no other band in the Catholic music world that teaches about the Truths of the Catholic faith like The Thirsting. From confession to the Eucharist, the Trinity to Mary and from addictions of sin to freedom in Christ, The Thirsting offers songs that reflect on the whole meaning of being Catholic and living in Christ’s one holy Church. **How do I get to KC Live in the Kansas City Power & Light District?** The Kansas City Power & Light District is Kansas City’s newest, most exciting neighborhood development and is located in the heart of Downtown, between Grand Boulevard and Baltimore Street, and 12th Street and Truman Road. The District spans eight blocks of new restaurants, entertainment, nightlife and shopping.
