Operation Breakthrough is a nationally accredited, not-for-profit corporation that was started in 1971 by Sister Berta Sailer and Sister Corita Bussanmas as a response to requests from parents in the central city for quality child care for children of the working poor.

The program began with 50 infants, toddlers and preschoolers at 31st and Paseo. In 1976, it expanded to include before- and after-school care. The Center moved to its current location at 31st and Troost in 1981. Since that time, it has added a broad range of social services to meet the needs of the children and their families. In 2006, Operation Breakthrough completed an expansion and renovation project that doubled the size of the facility and increased its licensed capacity from 353 children to 674

The food pantry at their facility is running low, so please help us make sure these children have enough food for the summer months by sending the following to school with your child BY WEDNESDAY next week. A table will be set up in the hallway at the front entrance. Thank you for your participation!
