
Notice to All Parent Drivers for School Events!

If you would like to serve as a parent driver for any school event (field trip, scholars bowl, etc), you will need to create an account on CMGConnect.org. Here are Step-by-Step instructions on how to complete this process:

1. Open browser to cmgconnect.org.
2. Select “Kansas City, KS” as your archdiocese (not the one for Catholic Charities)
3. Complete the “Register for New Account” portion on right side of screen (3 parts - Account, Personal, Affiliation)

4. At the Affiliation portion of the registration:


- Select “Sacred Heart Parish - SHAWNEE” as your primary parish/school.

5. You may check as many options as you need depending on how you participate at SHOJ. You will be assigned various training videos depending on what you select. The DRIVER video is the most important one if you wish to drive students to and from field trips or activities.

6. After you click “Register my Account” you will be directed to your CMGConnect home page and you will be assigned a 12 minute video to watch, followed by a few questions to answer.

7. After answering the questions, please print your certificate.

8. Complete the form on the next page of the newsletter and turn it in to the school office along with your certificate.
