## Notice to All Parent Drivers for School Events!

If you would like to serve as a parent driver for any school event (field trip, scholars bowl, etc), you will need to create an account on [CMGConnect.org](http://CMGConnect.org).

CMG is Catholic Mutual Group, the company that provides insurance for our parish and school, and many other parishes in the archdiocese. This process is required for any and all parent drivers.

When you create an account, follow the prompts and indicate that you are a volunteer and a driver (on behalf of church). Once your account is created, you will watch a 12 minute video on defensive driving and then answer 7 or 8 questions about the video.

We have a one-page form you must complete as well. The whole process takes about 20 minutes (including the video).

Check your email next week as we will have a more detailed guide, with screenshots, as to how to complete this process.
